Islington and Saint Pancras Cemetery **First World War, Grave Walk Three**

The centenary of the First World War is being commemorated nationally from 2014 to 2018.

In Islington, nearly every family in the borough lost a father, brother or other relative on the battlefield during the conflict, and life on the home front was also a challenging and sometimes frightening experience.

The eventual cost was immeasurable, with over 1.25 million people losing their lives from Britain and its Empire and, of these, over 9,400 were Islington related.

This map takes you on a short walk to visit the graves of, and memorials to, people who took part in the First World War and are buried and remembered here. Most of the people here died of wounds as it was, and still is, policy to bury the fallen as close as possible to where they died. Some are family memorials but most are in the traditional Commonwealth War Grave Commission style of a simple Portland Stone headstone.

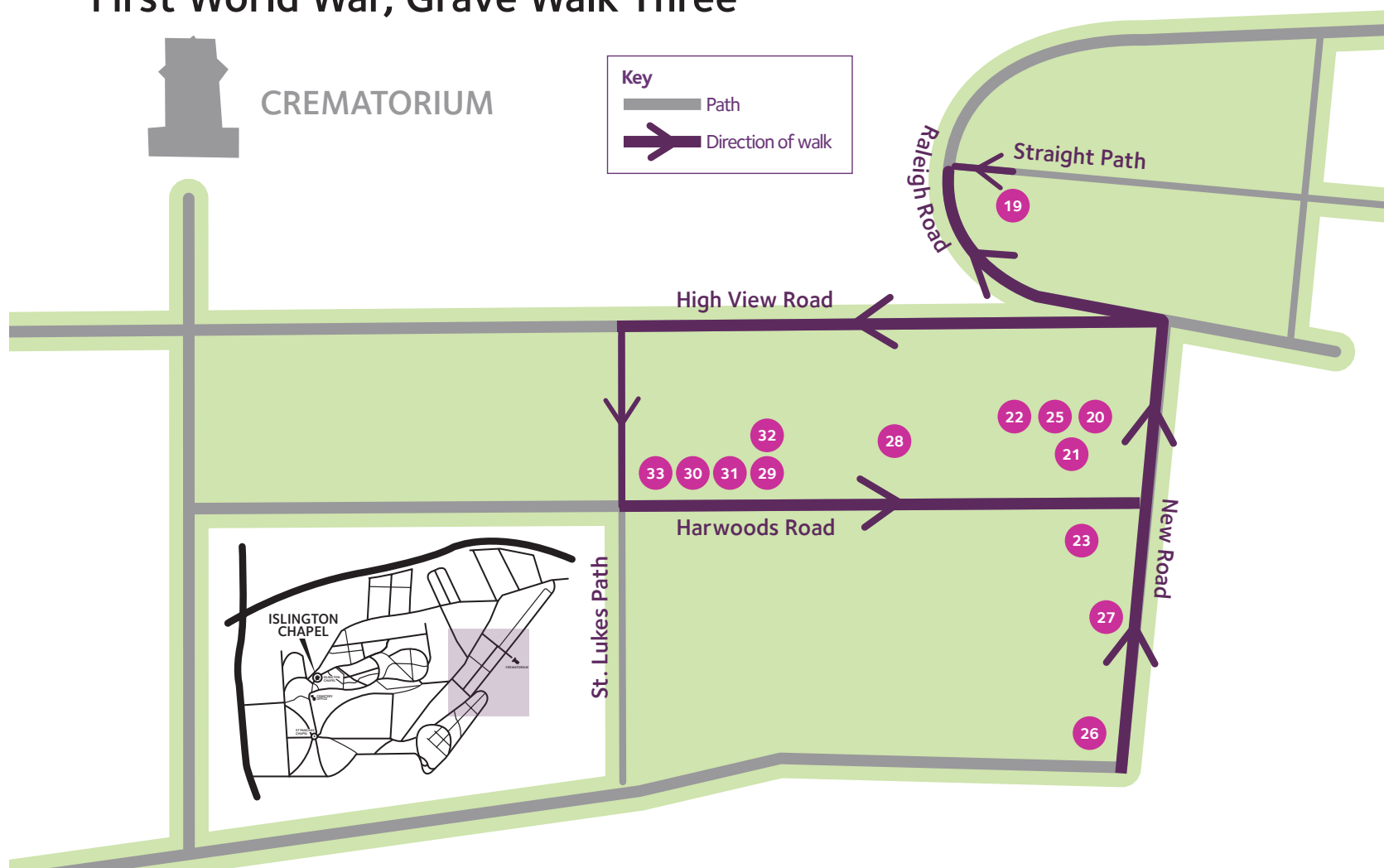
